

# WEST POINT ISLAND CIVIC ASSOCIATION 2025 Scholarship Opportunities

The West Point Island Civic Association (WPICA) is offering four \$750 scholarships to graduating high school seniors. The following outlines the criteria and documents needed to be eligible for each scholarship awarded this year.

# William S. Carey Memorial Scholarship

The West Point Island Civic Association is offering a \$750 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who is the *child or grandchild* of a current member of the *West Point Island Civic Association* and has been a member for the 2 years prior. This scholarship was established to honor the memory of William S. Carey, a founding member of the WPICA and leader in the secession movement of West Point Island from Dover Township (currently Toms River) to the Borough of Lavallette. This scholarship requires an essay themed "My Memories of West Point Island."

# Edgar J. Hess Memorial Scholarship

The West Point Island Civic Association is offering a \$750 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who is the *child or grandchild* of a current member of the *West Point Island Civic Association* and has been a member for the 2 years prior. This scholarship was established, by his family, in memory of Edgar J. Hess who was an active member of the West Point Island Civic Association. This scholarship requires an essay themed "What Have I Done to Make a Difference in My Community" and a letter of recommendation outlining community involvement ("community" need not be limited to Lavallette, NJ.)

#### WPICA Annual Memorial Scholarship

The West Point Island Civic Association is offering a \$750 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who is the *child or grandchild* of a current member of the *West Point Island Civic Association* and has been a member for the 2 years prior. This scholarship honors those members of WPICA who have passed away since last year's scholarships were awarded. This scholarship requires an essay themed "My Memories of West Point Island."

### Aileen M. Barow Memorial Scholarship

The West Point Island Civic Association is offering one \$750 scholarship to a graduating senior who is a *permanent resident of Lavallette*, including West Point Island. This scholarship honors the memory of Aileen M. Barow, former President of WPICA and Lavallette Mayor, whose leadership and dedication provided inspiration to all who knew her. This scholarship requires an essay themed "My Memories of Lavallette."

## To be eligible to receive a WPICA Scholarship applicants must also:

- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Demonstrate positive citizenship through service to others through school, church, and community.
- Be of good academic standing.
- Be planning to attend upon high school graduation a 4-year college/university or a 2-year community college, or a trade/technical school.

# 2025 WEST POINT ISLAND CIVIC ASSOCIATION Scholarship Application

The following items must be provided by the applicant to the WPICA Scholarship Committee the following items by **April 30, 2025**:

- 1. Must submit a copy of the letter of acceptance from the college, university, or technical/trade school he/she has been accepted to (preferably the school he/she plans to attend).
- 2. Each applicant must provide a two-page, double-spaced, typed essay as stated in the scholarship description.
- 3. For the Edgar J. Hess Scholarship please include a letter of recommendation outlining community involvement.
- 4. For maximum consideration please submit a resume listing leadership, athletic, and extra-curricular activities
- 5. Applicants who are applying for the William S. Carey Memorial Scholarship, WPICA Annual Memorial Scholarship and the Edgar J. Hess Memorial Scholarship are required to have been a WPICA member for 2 years prior (2023 and 2024).
